

SHOW AWARDS

Class Awards: The appropriate ribbons will be awarded to 1st – 6th place riders in each class. The 1st place rider in each class will receive an award. Ribbons/Award will not be awarded for Ride of Choice

Year End Award Qualifications: To qualify for TSHA Dressage & 2-Phase year end awards, the following criteria must be met:

- The exhibitor shall be a 2023 member of TSHA, with no outstanding debt to TSHA.
- Will be required to participate, as a member, in at least two (2) of the three (3) shows offered.

BANQUET AWARDS

Year End Awards: (open to exhibitors who meet all qualifications as listed)
The horse/rider team's Best three (3) scores from a minimum of two (2) different shows will be used to determine Divisional Year End placings.
All Special Needs Exhibitors who attend the Banquet will be recognized for their participation.

Overall Traditional Dressage High Percentage Award: Awarded to the horse/rider team competing in the Traditional Dressage classes, earning the highest percentage score in any Traditional Dressage test. Ties will be broken at the discretion of the Sponsor.
